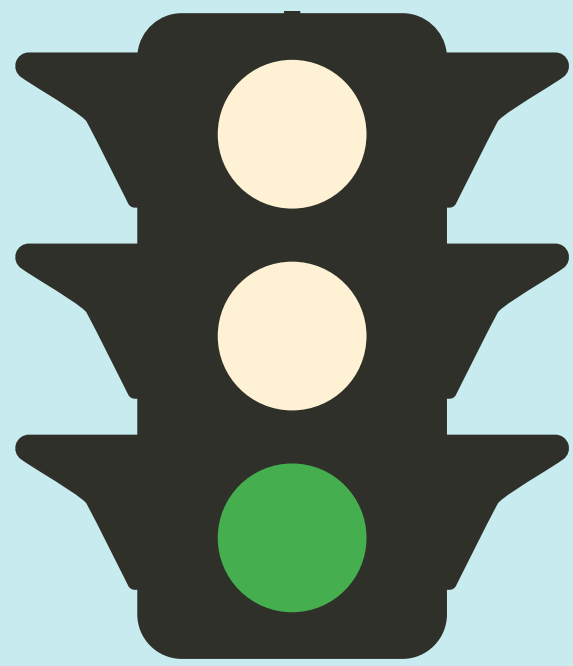


Cancer and COVID-19 Vaccine Eligibility

All cancer patients **SHOULD** be vaccinated. Although vaccine efficacy may be less in those on active treatment, don't delay. **ANY PROTECTION IS BETTER THAN NONE!**

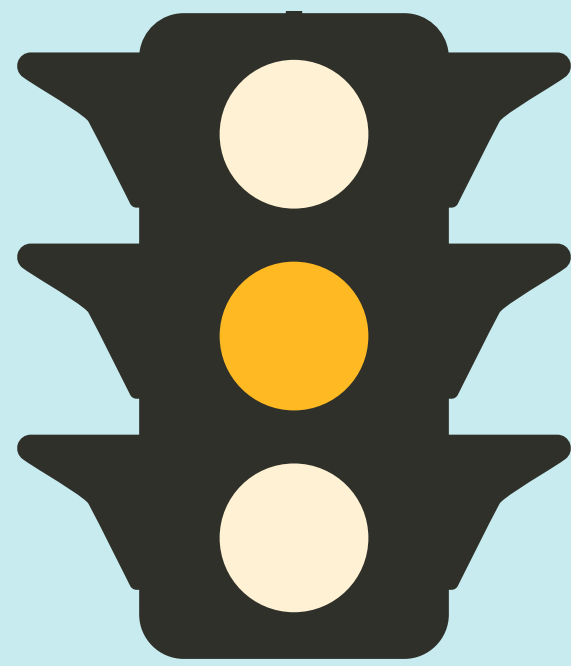

- chemotherapy
- targeted therapy
- immunotherapy
- endocrine therapy
- radiation therapy

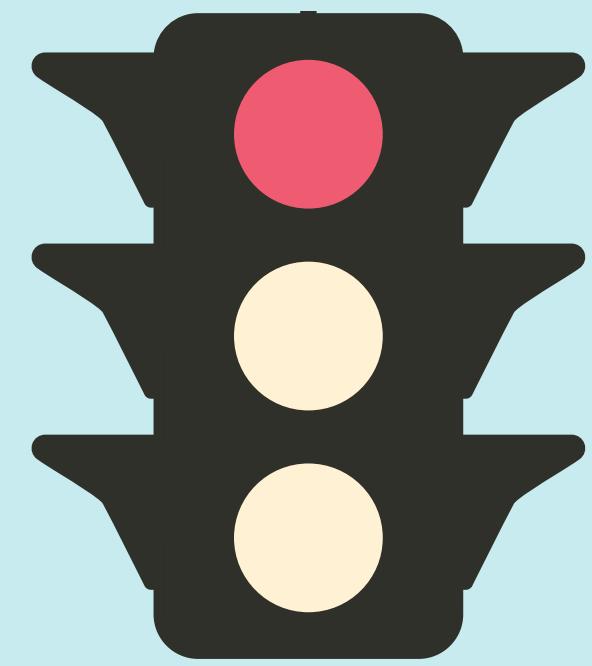
VACCINATE



CAUTION

- <3 months since Rituximab

TALK TO ONCOLOGIST



STOP

- <3-6 months since stem cell transplant
- <3 months since CAR T-cell therapy
- Previous anaphylactic reaction during chemotherapy

- Any of the available COVID-19 vaccines can be used for cancer patients
- Time vaccination a *few days* prior to chemotherapy cycles to maximize chance of response
- Patients on prednisone (or equivalent) ≥ 20 mg/day may be too immunosuppressed to respond to vaccination
